

History: This publication is a revision.

Summary. This regulation establishes policies, procedures, and responsibilities for the Test Control Officer (TCO), Alternate Test Control Officer (ATCO), Test Handler, and Administrators who safeguard the Signal Proponent Courseware taught through The Army School System (TASS).

Applicability. This regulation applies to only those assigned personnel who are authorized to handle Signal proponent testing material. It also covers the test construction course that will be offered by Staff and Faculty Development Section (SFDS), Directorate of Training (DOT).

Proponent and exception authority. The proponent of this regulation is the DOT.

Army management control process. This regulation does not contain management control provisions.
