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

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History: This publication is a revision.

Summary. This regulation provides policy governing the Quality Assurance (QA) Program. It covers evaluation/QA/assessment of the training, products, and institutions presenting training. Also covered is accreditation of training institutions and training product/material validation.

Applicability. This regulation applies to all elements of evaluating the efficiency and effectiveness of training, training development, training products, and training support functions.

Proponent and exception authority. The proponent of the regulation is the United States Cyber Center of Excellence (USACyber COE) Quality Assurance Office (QAO).

Army management control process. This regulation does not contain management control provisions.

Supplementation. Supplementation of this regulation is prohibited unless approved specifically by Commander, United States Army Cyber COE ATTN: ATZH-DCQ, Fort Gordon, Georgia 30905. (USACyber COE&FG)
