

INSTALLATION WATER UPDATE as of 6:00 p.m., Feb. 10:

Bulk distribution of water will continue at Gym 5 for the Commands, Brigades and Separate Battalions on 11 Feb 16. Water Buffalos will also remain spread throughout the cantonment area and are a primary source of potable water for all Fort Gordon personnel and will be refilled twice or more during the day. They are accessible 24 hours a day.

Bulk water is on hand to last through Friday-Saturday, and resupply sources are identified in the event this becomes a prolonged event.

Water system tests and way-ahead has not yet been released by GA Environmental Protection Division and will require coordinated system reset on Fort Gordon. The installation will not return to ALL CLEAR immediately after the GA EPD ALL CLEAR because actions will be required at the facility level, similar to what homes affected off-post will be urged / directed to do, before we give ALL CLEAR on the installation. Those actions will be identified once GA EPD defines what needs to be done based on final test results.

The Fort Gordon EOC with associated Unit and Staff Liaison personnel will remain active until after the Fort Gordon on-post ALL CLEAR is provided.

Due to the on-going water advisory, some installation facilities will be closed and services curtailed.

- **Freedom Park Elementary School: Closed**

- **Child Development Centers: Open**

- **DENTAC:** Dental Clinics have reopened and is resuming normal operation.

- **Child, Youth, & School Services (CYSS):**

CYSS will be able to provide full day care for those registered patrons affected by the closing of the Richmond County School System (RCSS).

GA Pre-K program will be closed. Patrons registered for before or after Pre-K and Kindergarten care will be provided all day care.

Before or After School Age Services Patrons will be provided full day care for Richmond County School students.

- **The EXCHANGE:** All food operations will remain closed—EXCEPT Godfathers and Subway at Building 29722.

- **DDEAMC:**

- Dining facility will be serving hospital patients and staff only.
- Scoping and "GI" Clinic appointments will not be seen.

- **Directorate of Family and Morale, Welfare and Recreation (DFMWR):**

- Food services and facilities capabilities will be reduced.

- Limited food operations for Thursday: Fitness Center Juice Bars, Alternate Escape Café, Gordon's Conference & Catering, Bowling Center 3-9 p.m. only, Bingo Palace Snack Bar 5-10 p.m. & Dominos.

CLOSURES: Towers Café, MWR Café, Bogey's Grill, MeMe, BoBo's Chinese & Huddle House

- **DeCA:** Limited deli; lunch sandwiches will be available. Fresh cut beef from Robbins AFB will be available Thursday.

Some mission commands may make decisions to curtail some mission operations. For information on reporting to individual duty call, please contact your chain of command.

The following Water Advisory Do's and Don'ts remain in effect as provided by the Preventive Health Team, DDEAMC:

DO THE FOLLOWING:

Follow the Public Advisory issued by the Georgia Department of Natural Resources. Bring tap water to a rolling boil for at least one minute before using for drinking or cooking (to include preparing any baby food/formula). Drink BOTTLED Water. Use bottled water to brush your teeth. Shower (Do not allow water in mouth and eyes).

DON'T USE TAP WATER FOR THE FOLLOWING:

DO NOT DRINK THE WATER

DO NOT ALLOW UNTREATED WATER INTO EYES OR MOUTH

DO NOT WASH FOOD ITEMS / CONSUMABLES WITH TAP WATER

DO NOT USE ICE FROM ICE MACHINES CONNECTED TO THE AFFECTED WATER SOURCE

DO NOT USE TAP WATER TO BRUSH YOUR TEETH
