SUBJECT: Installation Food Service Policy Memorandum, Ice Support for Training

1. Reference: AR 30-22, Army Food Program, 10 May 05.
2. This memorandum provides guidance, assistance, and responsibilities for personnel requiring ice support.
3. Effective immediately, the Logistics Readiness Center (LRC)/Installation Food Service Office will no longer coordinate ice support for units or offsite agencies that train on Fort Gordon. This is in keeping with the same baseline support that other installations provides. All ice support requirements will be at the respective organization's brigade. Brigades on Fort Gordon will be responsible for ordering, purchasing, receiving, and issuing ice. To support this transition, LRC will coordinate with Reddy Ice to provide ice storage containers in the brigade areas to support their ice requirements. Reddy Ice will provide these ice storage containers at no cost to the customers. The ice storage containers have the capacity of storing 80 twenty-pound bags of ice in each bin. The units are charged with selecting a site for the containers, coordinating with DPW for power, establishing an account with Reddy Ice, and providing POCs to coordinate for installation of the containers.
4. Agencies such as Cadets and Boys Scouts, will be supported by their sponsoring unit. Units that do not elect to get an ice storage container will have to use local approved commercial ice sources. All ice will be purchased on a government purchase card and procurement is for official use only.
