

Legacy STAMIS Descriptions and GCSS-Army TUCs

The legacy Standard Army Management Information System (STAMIS) descriptions are defined by the Logistics Support Activity (LOGSA) and used to determine the type unit codes (TUCs) for use in GCSS-Army. Within GCSS-Army the TUCs are restrictive and define which Classes/ Sub-classes of supply that a unit can order. Units are required to review their STAMIS description and corresponding GCSS-Army TUCs and ensure your STAMIS description is correct. Any and all changes to your STAMIS description must be completed and reflected within LOGSA prior to your D-75 “Go Live” date. Failure to complete this action prior to D-75 may require you to request a new DODAAC(s).
