### JOB DESCRIPTION:

The Senior Social Network Analyst shall perform all-source analysis via language enabled social media exploitation. The Social Network Analyst shall have firsthand experience targeting networks or individuals within networks, identifying vulnerabilities for exploitation, and drawing analytic conclusions on military forces disposition and activities. Is responsible for providing intelligence analysis and all aspects of information gathering, research, and predictive analysis.

The Senior Social Network Analyst will provide advance social network analysis and have an understanding of state-of-the-art social network techniques, methodologies and tools in support of multi-INT analysis products. The Senior Social Network Analyst will research emerging open source and social media applications of social networking, collaborate with industry and academia subject matter experts, and interface with other Government agencies to identify new and emerging social network analysis (SNA) methodologies, techniques and analytical tools. Shall employ Social media intelligence methodologies and area knowledge to help characterize military forces, related support and auxiliary networks and individuals within networks, and to identify vulnerabilities for policy options. The Social Media all-source analyst will fuse acquired intelligence into the Military Forces overall intelligence efforts.

### MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

- Requires 8 + years All Source Intelligence Analysis experience.
- Must be proficient in utilizing requisite computer applications and intelligence related automation to support analytical efforts and product development.
- Possess the skills to combine OSINT/ Social Network intelligence with all other INTs to determine pattern of life, location, and activity assessments of military forces.
- Must have strong briefing skills and be capable of effectively directing subordinate analysts in the accomplishment of intelligence products and assessments.
