MEMORANDUM FOR All Fort Gordon Personnel

SUBJECT: Garrison Commander's Policy Memorandum No. 19 – Identification (ID) Card Priority

1. The following personnel have priority at the Fort Gordon Identification Card Section, Room 161, Darling Hall:

- Warrior Transition Soldiers and Family Members.
- O-6 Commanders and O-6 level Senior Enlisted Advisors.
- Soldiers undergoing Soldier Readiness Processing for deployment.
- Next-of-kin of deceased Military Members escorted by a Casualty Assistance Officer.
- Individuals with obvious medical limitations/disabilities as determined by ID card personnel.

2. Occasionally, the ID Card Section becomes unable to issue ID cards due to power outage or loss of system connectivity. Customers present at such times will be able to put their name on a priority list at the front desk and have priority anytime during the next duty day.

3. For customers who are physically challenged, the ID Card Section does have a wheelchair for their use, as needed.
