### The Teal Hash Report contains Sexual Assault Related Courts-Martial Verdicts of Trial

In an effort to ensure that the Sexual Assault Prevention and Response (SAPR) information is disseminated to the CCoE and Ft Gordon personnel, the Teal Hash is published quarterly. The verdicts published in this Teal Hash focus on the Second Judicial Circuit (Southeast) and include Eglin AFB, Fort Benning, Fort Bragg, Fort Gordon, Fort Rucker, and Fort Stewart.

#### Crime Victims Rights

- The right to be reasonably protected from the accused.
- The right to reasonable, accurate, and timely notice.
- The right not to be excluded from any public proceedings.
- The right to be reasonably heard.
- The reasonable right to confer with government's attorney.
- The right to full and timely restitution as provided in law.
- The right to proceedings free from unreasonable delay.
- The right to be treated with fairness with respect for the victim's dignity and privacy.

### Sexual Assault Related Courts-Martial Results of Trial

#### Fort Stewart, Oct. 19

**Name:** SPC Paul J. Parreault

**Conviction:** By a military judge, pursuant to his pleas, of two specifications of distributing child pornography in violation of Article 134, UCMJ.

**Sentence:** Reduced to the grade of E-1, confined for 18 months, bad-conduct discharge.

#### Fort Bragg, Oct. 28

**Name:** SGT McKinley P. Armour

**Conviction:** By a military judge, contrary to his plea, of one specification of abusive sexual contact in violation of Article 120, UCMJ.

**Sentence:** Confined for 12 months, bad-conduct discharge.

#### Fort Bragg, Oct. 28

**Name:** SPC Marco A. Reyes

**Conviction:** By a military judge, contrary to his pleas, of two specifications of conspiring to obstruct justice, one specification of disobeying a commissioned officer, one specification of rape, four specifications of sexual assault, one specification of wrongful appropriation, one specification of larceny, two specifications of assault consummated by a battery, three specifications of adultery, and three specifications of obstructing justice in violation of Articles 81, 90, 120, 121, 128, and 134, UCMJ.

**Sentence:** Reduced to the grade of E-1, confined for 13 years, dishonorable discharge.

### Sexual Assault Related Courts-Martial Results of Trial

#### Fort Bragg, Nov. 2

**Name:** SFC Shane G. Gillins

**Conviction:** By a military judge, pursuant to his pleas, of two specifications of aggravated sexual assault of a child in violation of Article 120, UCMJ.

**Sentence:** Reduced to the grade of E-1, confined for 16 months, bad-conduct discharge.

#### Fort Bragg, Nov. 8

**Name:** SFC Colby D. Hunsaker

**Conviction:** By a military judge, pursuant to his pleas, of one specification of disobeying a lawful order, one specification of rape of a child, three specifications of aggravated sexual contact upon a child, five specifications of sexual assault of a child, three specifications of sexual abuse of a child, and one specification of adultery in violation of Articles 92, 120, 120b, and 134, UCMJ .

**Sentence:** Reduced to the grade of E-1, , forfeit all pay and allowances, confined for 80 years, dishonorable discharge. As a part of an offer to plead guilty, a pretrial agreement limited confinement to 40 years.

#### Fort Benning, Nov. 16

**Name:** SPC Alexander Carabarin

**Conviction:** By a military judge, pursuant to his pleas, of one specification of attempted sexual assault of a child, one specification of sexual assault of a child, and two specifications of sexual abuse of a child in violation of Articles 80 and 120b, UCMJ.

**Sentence:** Reduced to the grade of E-1, confined for 2 years, dishonorable discharge. As a part of an offer to plead guilty, a pretrial agreement limited confinement to 18 months and commute a dishonorable discharge to a bad-conduct discharge.

#### Fort Stewart, Dec. 1

**Name:** PFC David Dimas

**Conviction:** By a military judge, pursuant to his pleas, of two specifications of abusive sexual contact and one specification of sexual assault in violation of Article 120, UCMJ.

**Sentence:** Reduced to the grade of E-1, to confined for 10 months, dishonorable discharge.

#### Fort Bragg, Dec. 7

**Name:** SPC Joseph P. Robinson

**Conviction:** By a military judge, contrary to his pleas, of three specifications of sexual abuse of a child in violation of Article 120b, UCMJ.

**Sentence:** Reduced to the grade of E-1, to confined for 10 years, dishonorable discharge.
