In an effort to ensure that the Sexual Assault Prevention and Response (SAPR) information is disseminated to the CCoE and Ft Gordon personnel, the Teal Hash is published quarterly. The verdicts published in this Teal Hash focus on, but is not limited to, the Second Judicial Circuit (Southeast) and include Eglin AFB, Fort Benning, Fort Bragg, Fort Gordon, Fort Rucker, and Fort Stewart.

### Sexual Assault Related Courts-Martial Results of Trial

#### Fort Carson, CO Apr 13

**Name:** PVT Joe A. Garcia Jr.

**Conviction:** By a military judge, pursuant to his pleas, of seven specifications of rape of a child, two specifications of sexual abuse of a child, one specification of producing child pornography, one specification of distributing child pornography, and one specification of possessing child pornography in violation of Articles 120, 120b, and 134, UCMJ.

**Sentence:** Forfeit all pay and allowances, confined for 60 years, dishonorable discharge.

#### Fort Polk, LA Apr 11

**Name:** SGT James N. Beverly

**Conviction:** By a military judge, pursuant to his pleas, of two specifications of indecent visual recording in violation of Article 120c, UCMJ.

**Sentence:** Confined for 13 months, bad-conduct discharge.

#### Fort Knox, KY Apr 04

**Name:** SSG Gene R. Rouse

**Conviction:** By a military judge, contrary to his pleas, of one specification of forcible sodomy and one specification of assault consummated by battery in violation of Articles 125 and 128, UCMJ.

**Sentence:** Confined for 4 years, bad-conduct discharge.

#### Fort Drum, NY Apr 25

**Name:** SFC Samuel R. Wiles,

**Conviction:** By a military judge, contrary to his plea, of one specification of indecent viewing in violation of Article 120c, UCMJ.

**Sentence:** Reduced to E-1, confined for 120 days, bad-conduct discharge.

#### Camp Casey, S. Korea Apr 21

**Name:** CPT Christopher S. Berger

**Conviction:** By a military judge, pursuant to his pleas, of one specification of conspiracy, one specification of conduct unbecoming an officer, two specifications of soliciting the distribution of child pornography, three specifications of viewing child pornography, one specification of possessing child pornography, and one specification of receiving child pornography in violation of Articles 81, 133, and 134, UCMJ.

**Sentence:** Confined for 3 years, dismissed.

#### Fort Sill, OK Apr 20

**Name:** SGT Steven J. Furgerson

**Conviction:** By a military panel composed of officer and enlisted members, contrary to his plea, of one specification of sexual assault in violation of Article 120, UCMJ.

**Sentence:** Dishonorable discharge.

#### Fort Campbell, KY Apr 28

**Name:** PFC Justin K. Williams

**Conviction:** By a military judge, pursuant to specification of rape and one specification of aggravated sexual contact in violation of Article 120, UCMJ.

**Sentence:** Confined for 20 months, dishonorable discharge.

### Sexual Assault Related Courts-Martial Results of Trial

#### West Point, NY May 04

**Name:** CDT Jacob D. Whisenhunt

**Conviction:** By a military panel of officer members, contrary to his pleas, of three specifications of sexual assault in violation of Article 120, UCMJ.

**Sentence:** Reprimanded, forfeit all pay and allowances, confined for 21 years, dismissed from the service.

#### Fort Benning, GA May 10

**Name:** PV2 Dillon A. Seymour

**Conviction:** By a military judge, pursuant to his pleas, of two specifications of disobeying a lawful order and two specifications of sexual assault in violation of Articles 92 and 120, UCMJ.

**Sentence:** Reduced to the grade of E-1, confined for 10 years, dishonorable discharge.

#### JB Elmendorf-Richardson, AK May 16

**Name:** PV2 Aron Castaneda

**Conviction:** By a military judge, pursuant to his pleas, of two specifications of sexual assault and one specification of unlawful entry in violation of Articles 120 and 134, UCMJ.

**Sentence:** Reduced to the grade of E-1, forfeit all pay and allowances, confined for 6 years, dishonorable discharge.

#### Kaiserslautern, Germany May 20

**Name:** SPC George F. Kallas

**Conviction:** By a military judge, pursuant to his pleas, of three specifications of attempted lewd acts upon a child in violation of Article 80, UCMJ.

**Sentence:** Confined for 18 months, dishonorable discharge.

#### Fort Sill, OK May 09

**Name:** SSG Casey R. West

**Conviction:** By a military judge, pursuant to his pleas, of five specifications of rape of a child and eight specifications of sexual abuse of a child in violation of Article 120b, UCMJ.

**Sentence:** Reduced to the grade of E-1, confined for 56 years, dishonorable discharge.

#### Rose Barracks, Germany May 11

**Name:** SFC Patrick F. Reddick

**Conviction:** By a military judge, pursuant to his pleas, of one specification of false official statements and two specifications of abusive sexual contact in violation of Articles 107 and 120, UCMJ.

**Sentence:** Reduced to the grade of E-1, forfeit all pay and allowances, confined for 16 months, bad-conduct discharge.

#### Fort Leonard Wood, MO May 18

**Name:** MSG Joshua G. Wilson

**Conviction:** by a military judge, pursuant to his pleas, of four specifications of disobeying a lawful general order, three specifications of cruelty and maltreatment, two specifications of abusive sexual contact, and one specification of obstructing justice in violation of Articles 92, 93, 120, and 134, UCMJ.

**Sentence:** Reduced to the grade of E-4, confined for 100 days, bad-conduct discharge.

### Sexual Assault Related Courts-Martial Results of Trial

#### Fort Bragg, NC Jun 01

**Name:** PVT Tyler Washington

**Conviction:** By a military panel composed of officers and enlisted members, contrary to his pleas, of one specification of abusive sexual contact in violation of Article 120, UCMJ.

**Sentence:** Confined for 30 days, bad-conduct discharge.

#### Fort Benning, GA Jun 06

**Name:** PVT John S. Burnworth

**Conviction:** By a military judge, pursuant to his pleas, of two specifications of possession of child pornography in violation of Article 134, UCMJ.

**Sentence:** Confined for 1 year, bad-conduct discharge.

#### Fort Bliss, TX Jun 14

**Name:** SPC Andrew W. Bowhall

**Conviction:** By a military judge, pursuant to his pleas, of one specification of sexual assault of a child and one specification of adultery in violation of Articles 120b and 134, UCMJ.

**Sentence:** Reduced to the grade of E-1, confined for 3 years, dishonorable discharge.

#### JB Lewis-McChord, WA Jun 20

**Name:** SSG Michael P. Malloy

**Conviction:** By a military panel composed of officers and enlisted members, contrary to his pleas, of three specifications of abusive sexual contact in violation of Article 120, UCMJ.

**Sentence:** Reduced to the grade of E-4, bad-conduct discharge.

#### Fort Eustis, VA Jun 26

**Name:** SSG Ramon Ewing

**Conviction:** By a military judge, pursuant to his pleas, of two specifications of aggravated sexual abuse of a child, one specification of indecent liberty with a child, one specification of sodomy-not involving force, four specifications of sexual assault of a child, and one specification of producing child pornography, in violation of Articles 120, 120b, 125, and 134, UCMJ.

**Sentence:** Reduced to the grade of E-1, confined for 75 years, dishonorable discharge.

#### Fort Sam Houston, TX Jun 22

**Name:** PVT Daniel S. Alcantara

**Conviction:** By a military judge, contrary to his pleas, of one specification of failure to obey order or regulation, one specification of sexual assault, one specification of aggravated sexual contact, and two specifications of abusive sexual contact, in violation of Articles 92 and 120, UCMJ.

**Sentence:** Confined for 25 years, dishonorable discharge.

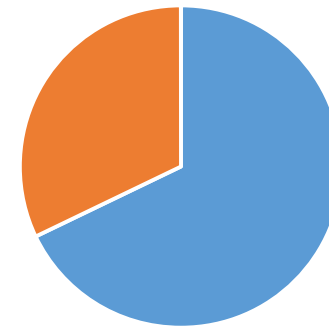


## TEAL HASH Training Statistics

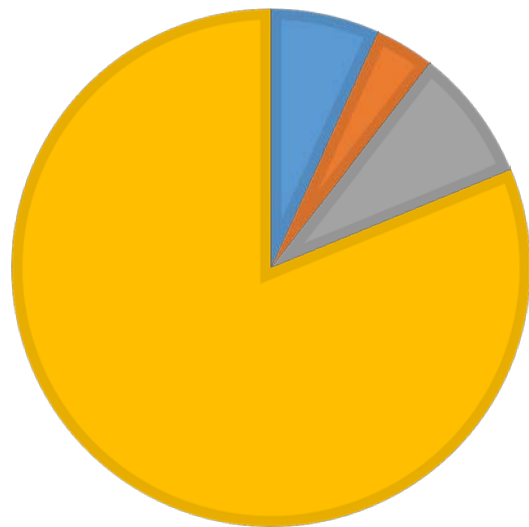
### Of the FY 2017 incidents that originated at Fort Gordon:

- 96% of Victims knew their Offender
- 89% of Victims were female
- 50% occurred on Fort Gordon
- 36% involved alcohol
- 75% of Victims were E1 – E4
- 29% of Offenders were E5 – CW3
- 43% of Victims were student status

- Historical



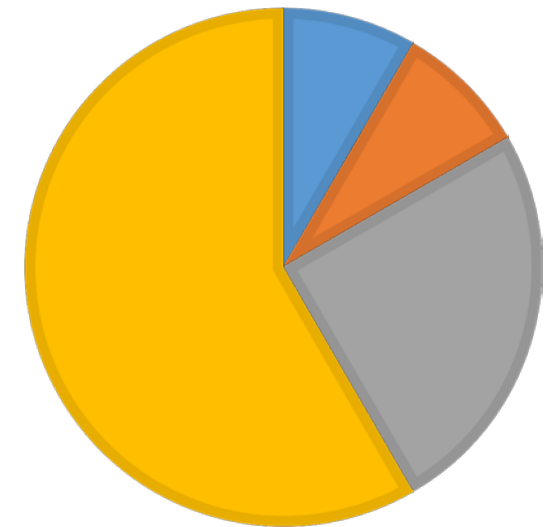
