- The right to be treated with fairness with respect for the victim's dignity and privacy.

Sexual Assault Related Courts-Martial Results of Trial

Fort Polk, 5 OCT 17

On 05 October 2017, at a general court-martial convened at Fort Polk, Louisiana, SSG David B. Jayroe, II, United States Army, was convicted by a military judge, contrary to his pleas, of three specifications of violating a lawful general order and one specification of abusive sexual contact, in violation of Articles 92 and 120, UCMJ. The accused was acquitted of two specifications of abusive sexual contact and one specification of assault consummated by a battery in violation of Articles 120 and 128, UCMJ. The military judge sentence

Bremerton, 12 OCT 17

At a General Court-Martial in Bremerton, Washington, ETVSN (E3) Jose J. Amaro, USN pled guilty pursuant to a pretrial agreement to two specifications of sexual assault. On 12 October 2017, the military judge sentenced him to be discharged with a Dishonorable Discharge, reduction to paygrade E-1, and confinement for 5 years. Pursuant to the pretrial agreement, all confinement greater than 24 months is to be suspended and only a Bad Conduct Discharge is to be approved

Fort Bragg, 12 OCT 17

On 12 October 2017, at a general court-martial convened at Fort Bragg, North Carolina, PVT Trevor L. Wright, United States Army, was convicted by a military judge, contrary to his plea, of one specification of sexual assault, in violation of Article 120, UCMJ. The accused was acquitted of two specifications of sexual assault, in violation of Article 120, UCMJ. The military judge sentenced the accused to be reduced to the grade of E-1, to be confined for 18 months, and to be discharged from the service with a dishonorable discharge.

Fort Campbell, 17 OCT 17

On 17 October 2017, at a general court-martial convened at Fort Campbell, Kentucky, a Private was acquitted by a military judge of one specification of rape of a child, in violation of Article 120b, UCMJ.

Fort Stewart, 24 OCT 17

On 24 October 2017, at a general court-martial convened at Fort Stewart, Georgia, SSG Keri L. Davis, United States Army, was convicted by a military judge, pursuant to his pleas, of one specification of failure to obey a lawful order and two specifications of adultery, in violation of Articles 92 and 134, UCMJ. The accused was convicted, contrary to his pleas, of two specifications of aggravated sexual assault of a child and two specifications of sodomy of a child, in violation of Articles 120 and 125, UCMJ. The accused was acquitted of one specification of carnal knowledge with a child, in violation of Article 120, UCMJ. The military judge sentenced the accused to be confined for 7 years and to be discharged from service with a dishonorable discharge.

Fort Gordon, 31 OCT 17

On 31 October 2017, at a general court-martial convened at Fort Gordon, Georgia, PFC Jason L. Walker, United States Army, was convicted by a military judge, pursuant to his pleas, of one specification of sexual assault and one specification of possession of alcohol under 21 years of age, in violation of Articles 120 and 134, UCMJ. The military judge sentenced the accused to be reduced to the grade of E-1, to forfeit all pay and allowances, to be confined for 18 months, and to be discharged from the service with a dishonorable discharge.

Sexual Assault Related Courts-Martial Results of Trial

San Diego, 8 NOV 17

At a General Court-Martial in San Diego, California, an E-5 was tried for four specifications of abusive sexual contact and one specification of attempted rape. On 8 November 2017, a panel of members returned a verdict of not guilty.

Yokosuka, 16 NOV 17

At a General Court-Martial in Yokosuka, Japan, YN2 Charlene Hayes, USN, was tried for sexual assault, abusive sexual contact and false official statement. On 16 November 2017, the panel of members found her guilty of false official statement and sentenced her to forfeit \$1275 per month for 1 month, reduction in rank to paygrade E-4, restriction for 30 days and confinement for 30 days.

Fort Gordon, 17 NOV 17

On 17 November 2017, at a general court-martial convened at Fort Gordon, Georgia, a Chief Warrant Officer 2, was acquitted by a military panel composed of officer members, of two specifications of sexual assault, in violation of Article 120, UCMJ.

Norfolk, 20 NOV 17

At a General Court-Martial in Norfolk, Virginia, CSSN (E-3) Alex J. Hines, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a pretrial agreement to sexual harassment, false official statement, and assault consummated by a battery. On 20 November 2017, the military judge sentenced him to be discharged with a Bad Conduct Discharge and confinement for 19 months. Pursuant to the pretrial agreement, all confinement greater than 18 months is to be suspended. The suspended punishment may be served if the Service Member violates the terms of the pretrial agreement.

Fort Hood, 30 NOV 17

On 30 November 2017, at a general court-martial convened at Fort Hood, Texas, SFC Carlos E. Barnes, United States Army, was convicted by a panel composed of officers and enlisted members, contrary to his pleas, of two specifications of providing alcohol to a minor, in violation of Article 134, UCMJ. The accused was acquitted of one specification of sexual assault, in violation of Article 120b, UCMJ. The members sentenced the accused to forfeit \$2,194.00 pay per month for 2 months.

Hurlburt, NOV 17

At Hurlburt AFB, FL, Captain Jonathan D. Shames was found guilty by officer members of abusive sexual contact and fraternization. He was sentenced to a dismissal, restriction to base for 10 days, total forfeiture of pay and allowances, and a reprimand.

Sexual Assault Related Courts-Martial Results of Trial

Fort Gordon, 6 DEC 17

On 06 December 2017, at a general court-martial convened at Fort Gordon, Georgia, PFC Darreon I. Scipio, United States Army, was convicted by a military judge, pursuant to his pleas, of two specifications of failure to obey a lawful order, one specification of sexual assault of a child, three specifications of wrongful appropriation, and one specification of housebreaking, in violation of Articles 92, 120b, 121, and 130, UCMJ. The military judge sentenced the accused to forfeit all pay and allowances, to be confined for 3 years, and to be discharged from the service with a dishonorable discharge. As part of an offer to plead guilty, a pretrial agreement limited confinement to 18 months.

Fort Benning, 8 DEC 17

On 08 December 2017, at a general court-martial convened at Fort Benning, Georgia, SSG Tony S. Springer, United States Army, was convicted by a military panel composed of officers and enlisted members, contrary to his pleas, of two specifications of assault consummated by a battery, in violation of Article 128, UCMJ. The accused was acquitted of six specifications of sexual assault, two specifications of abusive sexual contact, three specifications of sexual assault of a child, two specifications of assault consummated by a battery, and one specification of indecent language, in violation of Articles 120, 120b, 128, and 134, UCMJ. The members sentenced the accused to be reduced to the grade of E-4, to be confined for 90 days, and to be discharged from the service with a bad-conduct discharge.

Fort Wainwright, 12 DEC 17

On 12 December 2017, at a general court-martial convened at Fort Wainwright, Alaska, SGT Jeffrey D. Stalcup, United States Army, was convicted by a military judge, pursuant to his pleas, of one specification of violation of a lawful general regulation, one specification of sexual assault, and one specification of indecent exposure, in violation of Articles 92, 120, and 120c, UCMJ. The accused was acquitted of three specifications of false official statements, two specifications of rape, and three specifications of sexual assault, in violation of Articles 107 and 120, UCMJ. The judge sentenced the accused to be reduced to the grade of E-1, to be confined for 3 years, and to be discharged from the service with a dishonorable discharge.

Pensacola, 12 DEC 17

At a General Court-Martial in Pensacola, Florida, ENS Charles D. Hopgood-Rios, USN pled guilty pursuant to a pretrial agreement to three specifications of attempted sexual abuse of a child, attempted distribution of child pornography, solicitation of another to commit an offense, distribution of child pornography, indecent language, receipt of child pornography, two specifications of possession of child pornography, and three specifications of solicitation of another to commit an offense. On 12 December 2017, the military judge sentenced him to a Dismissal, to forfeit all pay and allowances, and confinement for 27 years. Pursuant to the pretrial agreement, all confinement greater than 36 months is to be suspended and remitted.
