The verdicts published in this Teal Hash focus on, but is not limited to, the Second Judicial Circuit (Southeast) and include Eglin AFB, Fort Benning, Fort Bragg, Fort Gordon, Fort Rucker, and Fort Stewart.

Crime Victims Rights

- The right to be reasonably protected from the accused.
- The right to reasonable, accurate, and timely notice.
- The right not to be excluded from any public proceedings.
- The right to be reasonably heard.
- The reasonable right to confer with government's attorney.
- The right to full and timely restitution as provided in law.
- The right to proceedings free from unreasonable delay.
- The right to be treated with fairness with respect for the victim's dignity and privacy.

Sexual Assault Related Courts-Martial Results of Trial

Fort Benning, 16 APR 18

On 16 April 2018, at a general court-martial convened at Fort Benning, Georgia, SPC Kevin L. Smith, United States Army, was convicted by military judge, pursuant to his pleas, of one specification of rape of a child and two specifications of sexual abuse of a child, in violation of Article 120b, UCMJ. The military judge sentenced the accused to be reduced to the grade of E-1, to be confined for 7 years, and to be discharged from the service with a dishonorable discharge. As part of an offer to plead guilty, a pretrial agreement limited confinement to 5 years.

Fort Sill, 02 APR 18

On 02 April 2018, at a general court-martial convened at Fort Sill, Oklahoma, PFC John A. Hayes, United States Army, was convicted by a military judge, pursuant to his plea, of one specification of false official statement in violation of Article 107, UCMJ. The accused was acquitted by a military panel composed of officers and enlisted members of two specifications of sexual assault and one specification of assault consummated by a battery in violation of Articles 120 and 128, UCMJ. The members sentenced the accused to be reduced to the grade of E-1.

Fort Sill, 04 APR 18

On 04 April 2018, at a general court-martial convened at Fort Sill, Oklahoma, PFC John A. Hayes, United States Army, was convicted by a military judge, pursuant to his pleas, of one specification of wrongful use of a controlled substance, one specification of wrongful possession of a controlled substance, and one specification of wrongful possession of drug paraphernalia, in violation of Articles 112a and 134, UCMJ. The accused was convicted by the military judge, contrary to his pleas, of one specification of violation of a lawful order and one specification of indecent exposure, in violation of Articles 92 and 120, UCMJ. The military judge sentenced the accused to be reduced to the grade of E-1, and to be discharged from the service with a bad-conduct discharge.

Eglin AFB, APR 18

At Eglin AFB, FL, Airman Faraz A. Wassan was found guilty by officer members of sexual assault of a child and sexual abuse of a child. He was sentenced to a dishonorable discharge, confinement for 11 months, reduction to Airman Basic (E-1), total forfeiture of pay and allowances and a reprimand.

Tyndall AFB, APR 18

At Tyndall AFB, FL, Master Sergeant Alan L. Leiby was found guilty by officer members of sexual assault. He was sentenced to a dishonorable discharge, confinement for 2 years, reduction to Airman Basic (E-1) and total forfeiture of pay and allowances.

Norfolk USN, VA, 10 APR 18

At a General Court-Martial in Norfolk, Virginia, AO3 Dashawn Nichol, USN, was tried for rape and sexual assault. On 10 April 2018, the panel of members returned a verdict of guilty and sentenced him to be discharged with a Dishonorable Discharge, to forfeit all pay and allowances, reduction in rank to paygrade E-1, and confinement for 25 years.

Mayport USN, FL, 6 APR 18

At a General Court-Martial in Mayport, Florida, MA3 Dante J. Breaux, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a pretrial agreement to three specifications of sexual harassment and four specifications of assault consummated by a battery. On 6 April 2018, the military judge sentenced him to be discharged with a Bad Conduct Discharge, reduction in rank to paygrade E-1, and confinement for 7 months. The pretrial agreement had no effect on his sentence.

Sexual Assault Related Courts-Martial Results of Trial

Fort Campbell, Kentucky, 30 APR 18

On 30 April 2018, at a general court-martial convened at Fort Campbell, Kentucky, SFC Richard W. Gilliam, United States Army, was convicted by a military judge, contrary to his pleas, of two specifications of rape of a child and one specification of sexual abuse of a child, in violation of Articles 120 and 120b, UCMJ. The accused was acquitted of three specifications of sexual abuse of a child, one specification of indecent liberties, one specification of rape of a child, one specification of committing lewd acts upon a child, and two specifications of wrongfully producing child pornography, in violation of Articles 120 (between Oct 07 and Sep 12), 120b and 134, UCMJ. The military judge sentenced the accused to be reduced to the grade of E-1, to be confined for 11 years, and to be discharged from the service with a dishonorable discharge.

Fort Hood, Texas, 03 APR 18

On 03 April 2018, at a general court-martial convened at Fort Hood, Texas, a Private First Class, was acquitted by a military judge of one specification of attempt to commit a sexual assault and one specification of aggravated sexual contact in violation of Articles 80 and 120, UCMJ.

Fort Riley, Kansas, 05 April 18

On 05 April 2018, at a general court-martial convened by the Fort Riley, Kansas, a Private First Class, was acquitted by a military panel composed of officers and enlisted members of two specifications of sexual assault in violation of Article 120, UCMJ.

Fort Hood, Texas, 10 APR 18

On 10 April 2018, at a general court-martial convened at Fort Hood, Texas, PFC Javier R. Huerta-Clifton, United States Army, was convicted by a military judge, pursuant to his pleas, of two specifications of sexual assault in violation of Article 120, UCMJ. The military judge sentenced the accused to be reduced to the grade of E-1, to forfeit all pay and allowances, to be confined for 18 months, and to be discharged from the service with a dishonorable discharge.

Norfolk, VA, 14 FEB 18

On 12 April 2018, at a general court-martial convened at Fort Riley, Kansas, a Private First Class, was acquitted by a military panel composed of officers and enlisted members of two specifications of sexual assault in violation of Article 120, UCMJ.

Fort Polk, Louisiana, 17 APR 18

On 17 April 2018, at a general court-martial convened at Fort Polk, Louisiana, SPC Christopher X. Jones, United States Army, was convicted by a military judge, pursuant to his pleas, of one specification of rape of a child and two specifications of sexual abuse of a child, in violation of Article 120b, UCMJ. The military judge sentenced the accused to be reduced to the grade of E-1, to forfeit all pay and allowances, to be confined for 15 years, and to be discharged from the service with a dishonorable discharge. As part of an offer to plead guilty, a pretrial agreement limited confinement to 7 years.

Sexual Assault Related Courts-Martial Results of Trial

Ft Bragg, NC, 05 JUN 18

On 05 June 2018, at a general court-martial convened at Fort Bragg, North Carolina, SPC Anthony Rodriguez, United States Army, was convicted by a military judge, pursuant to his pleas, of one specification of sexual assault in violation of Article 120, UCMJ. The military judge sentenced the accused to be reduced to the grade of E-1, to forfeit all pay and allowances, to be confined for 15 years, and to be discharged from the service with a dishonorable discharge.

Ft Bragg, NC, 06 JUN 18

On 06 June 2018, at a general court-martial convened at Fort Bragg, North Carolina, SPC Joshua D. Hall, United States Army, was convicted by a military judge, contrary to his plea, of one specification of sexual abuse of a child in violation of Article 120b, UCMJ. The military judge sentenced the accused to be reduced to the grade of E-1, to be confined for 48 months, and to be discharged from the service with a bad-conduct discharge.

Ft Bragg, NC, 13 JUN 18

On 13 June 2018, at a general court-martial convened at Fort Bragg, North Carolina, a Sergeant, was acquitted by a military panel composed of officers and enlisted members, of two specifications of aggravated sexual contact with a child, one specification of rape of a child, two specifications of sexual abusive contact with a child, one specification of aggravated sexual contact with a child, and one specification of aggravated sexual assault, in violation of Article 120, UCMJ (1 October 2007 - 27 June 2012).

Ft Bragg, NC, 20 JUN 18

On 20 June 2018, at a special court-martial convened at Fort Bragg, North Carolina, MSG Grady D. Dewitt, United States Army, was convicted by a military judge, pursuant to his pleas, of one specification of assault consummated by a battery in violation of Article 128, UCMJ. The accused was acquitted of one specification of abusive sexual contact and one specification of indecent exposure, in violation of Article 120, UCMJ. The military judge sentenced the accused to be reprimanded.

Ft Stewart, GA, 27 JUN 18

On 27 June 2018, at a general court-martial convened at Fort Stewart, Georgia, PFC Alexander L. Guenther, United States Army, was convicted by a military judge, pursuant to his plea, of one specification of sexual abuse of a child in violation of Article 120b, UCMJ. The military judge sentenced the accused to be confined for 5 months and to be discharged from the service with a bad-conduct discharge.

Ft Bragg, NC, 27 JUN 18

On 27 June 2018, at a general court-martial convened at Fort Bragg, North Carolina, a Sergeant First Class, was acquitted by a military panel composed of officers and enlisted members of two specifications of sexual assault in violation of Article 120 (after 28 June 2012), UCMJ.
